Motion by Councilman Kenneth Matassa, seconded by Councilman Terance Irvin to approve the request of our Legislative Delegation, Senator Jody Amedee, Representative Johnny Berthelot, and Representative Ed Price to commit an annual amount of \$25,000 to the Jambalaya Festival Association out of the \$75,000 allocated to the city from the parish-wide Hotel/Motel Tax, and to continue that allocation for as long as sufficient revenues are generated for the city from the Hotel/Motel Tax. AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCE CHAPTER 22. ZONING. SEC. 22-4 BOUNDARIES OF DISTRICTS TO APPROVE THE REZONING REQUEST OF MR. CHRISTAIN AVERY TO REZONE TRACT A SITUATED AT 208 E. CORNERVIEW FROM A B-1 ZONE TO A C-1 ZONE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY Mayor and Councilman of the City of Gonzales, Louisiana:

That the Code of Ordinance Chapter 22. Zoning. Section 22-4 Boundaries of Districts be hereby amended as follows:

Chapter 22. ZONING.

Sec. 22-4. Boundaries of Districts:

Tract A situated at 208 E. Cornerview Rd, Gonzales, La.



Fire Department 3.27mills


