Gonzales subject to Ad Valorem Taxation for the year 2020. The estimated amount of tax revenues to be collected in the next year from the increased millage is \$1,288,714 and the amount of increase in taxes attributable to the millage increase is \$28,063.”

Motion by Councilman Neal Bourque, seconded by Councilman David Guitreau to adopt Resolution No. 2901: A Resolution to approve the Mayor to sign an application for a loan in the amount of \$8,500,000 from USDA Rural Development in the name of the City pledging the 2% Hotel Occupancy Tax as the basis of repayment for the land acquisition, design, and construction of the Price LeBlanc Pace Center.


