PARISH OF ASCENSION Proclamation

LOCAL DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY PUBLIC HEALTH CONCERN COVID-19

WHEREAS, the City of Gonzales has declared a State of Emergency due to the public health threat from the virus SARS-CoV-2 and the disease it causes, named Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19); and

WHEREAS, Louisiana Governor John Bel Edwards has issued a series of Proclamations regarding the Public Health Emergency, including:

WHEREAS, on March 30 2021, Louisiana Governor John Bel Edwards issued Proclamation Number 66 JBE 2021 to extent "COVID-19 Resilient Louisiana – Phase 3," following guidance of "Opening Up America Again" from the White House Coronavirus Task and to renew the state of emergency for Covid-19 and extend the emergency provisions; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gonzales supports all the above referenced Proclamations by Governor Edwards' in their entirety and hereby incorporates its provisions, where applicable, by reference in this order by the mayor;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED, that I, Barney D. Arceneaux, Mayor of the City of Gonzales, Parish of Ascension, State of Louisiana, do hereby proclaim the provisions of this order will remain in effect until April 28, 2021 or as extended by any subsequent Proclamation, unless terminated sooner; and

FURTHER PROCLAIM, that as mayor I urge all citizens of Gonzales, and the businesses located within the City, to honor the Covid-19 guidelines, mask mandate and for citizens at higher risk of severe illness to continue to stay at home.
