1. All applicants will be considered but applying does not guarantee a space.
2. Sign-in is required Saturday morning no later than 7:30 am.
3. All spaces must be in operation no later than 8:30 am Saturday and no later than 11:00 am on Sunday. All spaces shut down by 5 pm. Violators may be asked to leave.
4. All spaces must be continually staffed during event hours.
5. Items for sale cannot be vulgar or offensive. Violators may be asked to leave.
6. Items for sale must be primarily as represented on the application form.
7. Exhibitors agree to be responsible for any damages or losses they or their staff may incur.
8. Spaces are first come first served. Exhibitors may swap space with another vendor if approved by City staff.
9. One business per tent.
10. Exhibitor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the City of Gonzales from and against any loss, expense, claims, damages, causes of action, injuries, suits or damages, suits to person or property, including attorney's fees, arising out of or related to the operation of the Exhibitor at the City of Gonzales 100 Year Celebration.
11. No dogs allowed per City Ordinance.
12. Alcohol and all intoxicating substances are prohibited.
13. Only family-friendly music allowed.
