LITTLE STEPS FOR BIG CHANGE

- Buy local foods and organic ingredients when possible
- Turn off lights when not in use
- Use a reusable water bottle

THREE TIPS FOR GROWING A SPRING CONTAINER GARDEN

FROM CONCHITA RICHEY, MASTER GARDENER, AND MEMBER OF THE GONZALES GARDENING CLUB

- 1. **Choose the right container.** Make sure the container you choose has proper drainage and if not, plan to drill holes to ensure soil can drain.
- 2. **Buy the correct soil.** Container gardens need potting soil rather than garden or topsoil and leave the soil about 2 inches from the top of the container.
- 3. **Buy plants that are compatible in growing conditions by each other.** Put shade plants together and sun-loving plants together to help them thrive.

BONUS TIP: Remember *Thriller, Filler, and Spiller* when arranging your container garden! Start with higher or thriller plants in the back, filler plants in the middle, and a type of spillover plant in the front.
