Mayor Ryland Percy called the Public Hearing to order at 5:30 p.m. to discuss adoption of Ordinance No. 4241: An Ordinance directing the renewal of the levy and collection of a tax of 3.27 mills on assessed valuation of all property subject to taxation in the city (an estimated \$576,122.00 reasonably expected at this time to be collected from the levy of the tax for an entire year) (the "TAX"), for a period of ten (10) years, beginning with the year 2026 and ending with the year 2035, with the proceeds of the tax (after paying reasonable and necessary costs and expenses of collection and administering the tax) to be dedicated and used for the purpose of paying the costs of constructing, maintaining, and operating fire department stations and equipment and providing for other matters in connection therewith.

Mayor Ryland Percy invited anyone who wished to speak to come forward.

No one came forward to speak in favor of or against adoption of the 2024 property tax millage rates.

At 5:31 p.m. Mayor Ryland Percy closed the Public Hearing.
