**ORDINANCE # 4284**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 22 – ZONING, SECTION 22-2 – ZONING DISTRICTS, TO APPROVE THE REQUEST OF DONALD L. PEOPLES, JR. TO REZONE PARCEL NO. 20041324, LOCATED ON LANOUX STREET, LOT 2B, FROM ZONE R-8 (RESIDENTIAL 8,000 SQ. FT. LOT SIZE) TO ZONE R-3-TH (RESIDENTIAL TOWNHOUSE) FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF NINE (9) TOWNHOUSE RESIDENTIAL UNITS.**

**BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Mayor and Councilmen of the City of Gonzales, Louisiana:

That the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gonzales be amended as follows:

Chapter 22. – Zoning

**Section 22-2. – Zoning Districts**

Rezone Parcel No. 20041324, located at 1502 Lanoux Street, identified as Lot 2B, from R-8 (Residential 8,000 Sq. Ft. Lot Size) Zoning District to R-3-TH (Residential Townhouse) Zoning District, for the construction of nine (9) townhouse residential units.


